Sixth, participate in more question and answer sessions. To improve your English quickly, you need to ask and answer a lot of questions. Don't just read the phrases. Ask why they are used in a certain way, if other constructions are possible, and don't believe everything you read on the Internet. Seventh, don't forget to have fun while learning, because it is better to achieve results through enjoyable exercises. If learning English seems difficult to you, it will seem boring and you will not achieve good results. That is why it is very important to stay motivated and enjoy learning a new language. Find ways to make your learning fun, such as playing word games with your friends that will improve your critical thinking skills.
