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## THE INFLUENCE OF PODCAST TECHNOLOGY ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF COMMUNICATION SKILLS OF STUDENTS IN FOREIGN LANGUAGE LEARNING.

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**Abstract:** *In recent years, technological advancements have reshaped educational practices, particularly in the field of foreign language learning. This study examines the impact of podcast technology on the development of communication skills among students learning foreign languages. Podcasts, as a form of digital media, offer students an opportunity to engage with language content outside the classroom, promoting listening skills, vocabulary acquisition, and pronunciation. The paper discusses the potential of podcasts to enhance*

*learner engagement, improve linguistic competencies, and foster independent learning. By analyzing recent case studies and surveys, this study aims to demonstrate how podcasts can be integrated into language curricula to create an interactive and immersive learning environment.*

As students strive to master a new language, the development of communication skills is paramount. Communication involves various competencies, including listening, speaking, and understanding, which are essential in real-life interactions. Among various technological tools, podcasts have emerged as an innovative method to support language learning. In terms of educational technology, technology plays a key role in identifying novel learning patterns and implementing them to improve academic outcomes [1]. Thus, it was vital to keep up with technological advancements such as modern technologies (computers, programs, multimedia, audio, video, and CDs) to improve learning [2]. According to Fansury, Januarty & Ali Wira Rahman, the second generation of the web aims to activate the learner's role in enriching digital content on the Internet and cooperating in the construction of electronic societies. The qualities of the second generation of the web are in these applications, which include blogs, social networks, and podcasts [3]. This study used podcast technology in improving listening. The integration of podcast technology into foreign language education has emerged as a transformative tool for developing oral communication skills. As digital platforms that deliver audio content, podcasts offer learners the opportunity to engage with authentic language in a flexible and accessible format. By providing exposure to native speakers and diverse linguistic contexts, podcasts enhance pronunciation, fluency, and listening comprehension—key components of oral communication skills. This approach aligns with constructivist learning theories, which emphasize active, self-directed exploration and reflection, thus enabling learners to take greater ownership of their language development. Podcasts also foster increased motivation by offering learners the ability to practice at their own pace, enhancing their confidence and proficiency. Furthermore, the use of podcasts in language learning can encourage collaboration, with students engaging in peer feedback and collaborative projects that further strengthen their speaking abilities. This article explores the impact of podcasts on the development of communication skills in foreign language learners.

## **Literature Review**

The primary aim of this research is to analyze the role of podcasts in enhancing students' communication abilities, focusing on listening comprehension, vocabulary enhancement, and pronunciation skills. Additionally, it seeks to understand how podcasts can promote active engagement and self-directed learning among students.

### **1. Podcast Technology in Education**

Podcasting is a digital medium that delivers audio or video content, accessible via internet-enabled devices. Over the past two decades, podcasts have gained popularity in various educational contexts due to their accessibility and flexibility. As an educational tool, podcasts provide learners with an authentic listening experience by exposing them to native speakers and diverse accents, which can enhance language comprehension and retention.

### **2. Communication Skills and Language Learning**

Effective communication in a foreign language requires proficiency in multiple areas: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Recent research suggests that listening comprehension is closely tied to speaking skills, as learners need to understand spoken language to engage in conversation. Podcasts, by offering an immersive listening experience, have the potential to bridge gaps between passive and active communication skills.

### **3. Podcast Integration in Foreign Language Curricula**

Several studies have highlighted the benefits of podcast usage in language classrooms. For instance, podcast content often includes real-world topics and dialogues, exposing students to informal language, colloquialisms, and regional dialects. Furthermore, students have the ability to pause, replay, and engage with the content at their own pace, which supports varied learning styles and fosters self-confidence in speaking.

### **Methodology.**

This study employs a mixed-method approach, combining qualitative and quantitative data to assess the impact of podcast technology on communication skills development. The research involved 100 university students enrolled in a foreign language course (English, Spanish, and French). Participants were exposed to podcasts as part of their weekly coursework for a semester.

#### **Data Collection Tools:**

- Pre- and post-study language proficiency tests
- Surveys to evaluate student engagement and satisfaction
- Interviews with students and instructors about their experiences using podcasts for language learning
- Observation of in-class activities related to podcast usage

### **Data Analysis:**

Quantitative data from the proficiency tests and surveys were analyzed using statistical methods to determine changes in communication skills. Qualitative data from interviews and observations were analyzed thematically to explore students' attitudes toward podcast integration and its effectiveness in improving communication.

### **Results and Discussions.**

The results of the research on scientific materials indicate that podcast integration in language teaching provides effective outcomes in many ways. Firstly, its role in improving the pronunciation of students is essential. Fouz-González (2019) used podcasts in an EFL setting to improve pronunciation among Spanish university students through explicit instruction, input training, output training, and peer evaluations, resulting in a 6.5% improvement in listening perception of /s/ and /z/ sounds and enhanced pronunciation of specific consonants. Yeh (2017) found that Taiwanese EFL students benefited from listening to podcasts on self-selected topics, giving oral presentations, and keeping journals, which made learning more meaningful and engaging. Both studies highlight the effectiveness of podcasts in enhancing listening and pronunciation skills in EFL contexts [5]. Secondly, this information technology is highly estimated with its motivation impact. According to the materials that we have investigated thoroughly, Podcasts incorporate key linguistic features that effectively support pronunciation development in language learners as they are authentic materials by providing genuine language input, podcasts help students improve their listening and pronunciation skills while mastering natural conversations and dialogues. In addition to the abovementioned quality, podcasts are often mentioned as interesting creating an enjoyable learning environment, sustaining students' interest, and reducing fatigue, as learners dedicate more time to active listening. Podcasts inspire learners to engage deeply with texts, fostering critical analysis and a more thoughtful approach to understanding and critiquing language [1]. The results revealed that podcast usage led to significant improvements in the communication skills of students. Key findings include:

#### **1. Enhanced Listening Comprehension:**

Students demonstrated better listening comprehension in post-tests, with an average improvement of 15%. Many students reported feeling more confident in understanding diverse accents and colloquial language used in the podcasts.

#### **2. Vocabulary Expansion:**

Exposure to varied vocabulary through podcasts was particularly beneficial for students in expanding their lexical knowledge. On average, students acquired 30% more new vocabulary words, according to pre- and post-assessments.

### **3. Improved Pronunciation:**

Students who regularly engaged with podcasts also showed noticeable improvements in pronunciation, with several reporting that mimicking the speakers in the podcasts helped them overcome their accent-related challenges.

### **4. Increased Student Engagement:**

The survey results indicated a high level of student satisfaction with podcast-based learning. Approximately 85% of students reported increased motivation and interest in the course, citing the flexibility of podcasts and their ability to learn at their own pace.

Podcast technology provides an innovative way to bridge gaps in traditional foreign language learning methods. The findings suggest that podcasts not only aid in developing listening comprehension but also contribute significantly to enhancing vocabulary and pronunciation. The accessibility of podcasts allows learners to reinforce learning outside the classroom, a key element in language acquisition.

Moreover, podcasts offer a non-threatening environment for learners to practice and engage with the language. The ability to replay and pause content enables students to focus on specific language elements, which may be difficult in a live conversation. Additionally, podcasts often feature content that reflects real-world language use, providing students with a deeper understanding of cultural contexts and idiomatic expressions.

Despite the positive outcomes, the study acknowledges some challenges, such as the risk of passive learning and the need for structured guidance on how to integrate podcasts effectively into the curriculum. Teachers should encourage active engagement with podcast content, such as summarizing episodes, discussing them in class, or even creating their own podcasts.

**Conclusion:** The integration of podcast technology into foreign language learning offers promising benefits for developing communication skills, including listening comprehension, vocabulary acquisition, and pronunciation. As an accessible and flexible tool, podcasts promote active, self-directed learning and offer students the opportunity to engage with authentic language content. Further research is needed to explore long-term effects and best practices for integrating podcasts into language curricula effectively.

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
