

AFFIXATION AS A PRODUCTIVE PROCESS OF WORD FORMATION IN ENGLISH

Annotatsiya

Affiksatsiya ingliz tilida so‘z yasalişining eng samarali va keng qo‘llaniladigan usullaridan biridir. U yangi leksik birliklarni yaratish yoki mavjud so‘zlarni o‘zgartirish maqsadida asos yoki ildizga affikslar qo‘shishni o‘z ichiga oladi. Ushbu maqolaning maqsadi affikslarning tuzilishi va funksiyalarini tahlil qilish, ularning asosiy turlarini aniqlash hamda lug‘at boyligini kengaytirishdagi rolini ko‘rsatishdan iborat. For example:

happy → unhappy agree → disagree write → rewrite

In these examples, the prefix changes the meaning of the base word.
